Wellness Manager's Message,

Summer is here and it's time to talk sun safety. Most of us like to work, play, and relax outside on a sunny day. But too much sun and heat can be harmful. Here are some tips to stay safe.

- 1. **Cover up.** Wear light-coloured, long-sleeved shirts, pants made from breathable fabric and a wide-brimmed hat.
- 2. **Limit your time in the sun.** Keep out of the sun and heat between 11:00am and 3:00pm. The UV index in Canada can be 3 or higher during those times.
- 3. **Use sunscreen.** Use sunscreen labelled "broad spectrum" and "water resistant" with an SPF of at least 30.
- 4. **Drink plenty of cool liquids.** Especially water before you feel thirsty.
- 5. **Avoid Tanning.** There is no such thing as a 'healthy' tan. Tanning damages your skin and increases your risk of developing melanoma, the deadliest form of skin cancer.
- 6. Wear sunglasses. Make sure they provide protection against both UVA and UVB rays.


